Female party stuck with her account, not disclosing any offences other than a verbal DA. Police Disclosure Page 4 and 27	She has then told these officers about the previous assault and stated that he strangled her before -- note that when asked by earlier officers if there had been any other assaults she said no, and she said no when ppn question about strangulation, possible this will need revisiting for clarification. Police Disclosure Page 4	During PPN questions the victim also disclosed that around 3 months ago, during an argument the suspect lost the temper and he grabbed her round the throat with one hand pushing her to the bed. She also disclosed that he has kicked her in the stomach previously, she thinks this was around 1 year ago. She could not provide any more details for either assault. On June 25, 2023, the Applicant submitted a request to EE to block and disable my private phone number, to which she had no rights. After the intervention of the judge during the initial hearing, my phone was unblocked. However, after a few days, it was blocked again, and only after my intervention was it unblocked once more. The Applicant on either the 24th or 25th of June 2023 filed a request for a restraining order, prohibiting me from approaching or having any contact with her.
